1 PROCEEDINGS 2 CHAIRMAN FAY: All right. Commissioners, next 3 we will be moving to Item No. 10, which will be 4 presented by Mr. Ward this morning. 5 Mr. Ward, we will give you a minute to set up and you can begin whenever you are ready. 6 7 MR. WARD: Good morning, Commissioners. 8 Item 10 is a petition by Duke Energy Florida for the approval of modifications to the tariffs 9 10 regarding the optional Load Profiler Online Service 11 and the Economic Development Rider. The optional 12 Load Profiler Online Service is available to 13 commercial customers requesting detailed 14 consumption data. 15 The utility is seeking to eliminate the 16 monthly and weekly report options available under 17 this program while lowering the costs of the daily 18 option. 19 Staff reviewed the cost support provided by 20 Duke, and believes this change will more accurately 21 reflect the cost of the program to the utility. 22 Additionally, Duke is seeking to add 23 additional criteria for determining the benefit of 24 new or expanded load under the Economic Development 25 Rider.

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1 Lastly, the utility is seeking to make non-substantive changes to the standard service 2 3 agreement for customers who participate in the economic development rider, including adding a line 4 5 to display the customer's percent discount offered under the Economic Development Rider. 6 7 Staff believes the proposed tariff changes are 8 reasonable and recommend approval. 9 CHAIRMAN FAY: All right. Commissioners, we 10 have a summary on Item No. 10. I will entertain 11 any questions. 12 With that, I will take up a motion on Item No. 13 10. 14 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Move to approve staff recommendation, Mr. Chairman. 15 16 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Second. 17 A motion and a second CHAIRMAN FAY: Okay. 18 for approval of staff recommendation on Item No. 19 10. 20 All that approve say aye. 21 (Chorus of ayes.) 22 CHAIRMAN FAY: Showing none opposed, Item 10 23 passes unanimously. 24 Thank you, Mr. Ward. 25 (Agenda item concluded.)
