# FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN CONTRACTUAL MATERIAL PROVIDED TO THE STAFF OF THE FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") requests confidential classification of certain contractual material provided to the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission ("Staff") pursuant to Staff's request. In support of this request, FPL states as follows:

- On July 5, 2023, Staff requested that FPL provide a copy of a contract document that is treated confidentially. Accordingly, FPL files this Request for Confidential Classification to maintain continued confidential handling of the document.
  - 2. The following exhibits are included with and made a part of this request:
- Exhibit A consists of a copy the confidential document. As the document is confidential in its entirety, the document is printed on yellow paper.
- b. Exhibit B consists of two copies of an identifying cover page indicating the document in Exhibit A is confidential it its entirety and therefore, is redacted in its entirety.
- c. Exhibit C is a table containing an identification of the confidential information in Exhibit A by page. Exhibit C also references the specific statutory basis for the claim of confidentiality and identifies the declarant who supports the requested classification.
  - d. Exhibit D is the declarations of Dan DeBoer in support of this Request.
- 3. FPL submits that the contract that comprises Exhibit A is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes. This information

is intended to be and is treated by FPL as private, and its confidentiality has been maintained. Pursuant to Section 366.093, such information is entitled to confidential treatment and is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the Commission determines that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.

- 4. As described more fully in the declaration included as Exhibit D, the requested document is an agreement between FPL and the Institute of Nuclear Power Operations ("INPO"), which contains the terms negotiated between the parties. This document relates to competitive interests of FPL and INPO, and its disclosure would impair the competitive business interests of both FPL and INPO. This information is protected by Section 366.093(3)(e), Fla. Stat.
- 5. Upon a finding by the Commission that the information highlighted in Exhibit A, and referenced in Exhibit C, is proprietary confidential business information, the information should not be declassified for a period of at least eighteen (18) months and should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. See § 366.093(4), Fla. Stat.

WHEREFORE, for the above and foregoing reasons, as more fully set forth in the supporting materials, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests that its Request for Confidential Classification be granted.
