2 CHAIRMAN FAY: All right. We will next move
3 to Item No. 6 to be presented by Mr. Kelley this
4 morning.

5 We will give you a second to get settled in
6 there, Mr. Kelley, and then whenever you are ready,
7 you are recognized.

8 MR. KELLEY: Good morning, Commissioners.
9 This is Patrick Kelley with Commission staff.

10 Item 6 is Tampa Electric Company's petition
11 for approval of revised underground residential
12 distribution tariffs. These tariffs apply to new
13 residential subdivisions, and represent the
14 additional costs, if any, TECO incurs to provide
15 underground distribution service in place of
16 overhead service.

17 TECO's proposed underground per service
18 lateral cost differentials for low density
19 subdivisions decreased from \$370.29 to zero
20 dollars, while high density subdivisions remained
21 at zero dollars.

22 Staff has reviewed this petition by Tampa
23 Electric Company proposing revised distribution
24 tariffs, as well as the company's response to
25 staff's data request. Staff believes the proposed

1 tariffs are reasonable and recommend Commission
2 approval.

3 Thank you.

4 CHAIRMAN FAY: Okay. Great.

5 Commissioners, you have a summary on Item No.
6 6. I will entertain any comments or a motion at
7 this time.
