2 CHAIRMAN FAY: All right. Last move staff
3 item we have this morning, Commissioners, is Item
4 No. 9, and it will be presented by Ms. Guffey.

5 Ms. Guffey, we will give you a second to get
6 set up there, and then you are recognized when you
7 are ready.

8 MS. GUFFEY: Good morning, Chairman and
9 Commissioners. Seveni Guffey with Commission
10 staff.

11 Item 9 is a petition from Peninsula Pipeline
12 Company requesting Commission approval of a new
13 20-year transportation service agreement with
14 Florida Public Utilities Company.

15 Pursuant to the agreement, beginning at the
16 Trenton Gas, the gate station, Peninsula will
17 construct approximately 20 miles of steel pipeline,
18 which will connect to a regulator station in
19 Newberry.

20 Benefits of the proposed project and agreement
21 are that they will allow FPUC to interconnect to
22 Florida Gas Transmission Company's less constrained
23 West Leg providing FPUC with additional source of
24 gas, and also support Newberry's economic
25 development plan and enable FPUC to expand its

1 distribution system in and around Newberry.

2 FPUC will pay Peninsula a negotiated monthly
3 reservation charge which FPUC will recover through
4 its PGA and swing service rider.

5 Staff has reviewed the petition, the parties'
6 agreement and responses to staff's data request.

7 Staff recommends approval of Peninsula's petition.

8 CHAIRMAN FAY: Great. Thank you, Ms. Guffey.
9 You and your team did a good job on this item. I
10 appreciate your work on this.

11 Commissioners, we will take any comments on
12 this item, and if not, we will take a motion on
13 Item No. 9.

14 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Move approval of the
15 item, Mr. Chairman.

16 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Second.

17 CHAIRMAN FAY: Okay. We have a motion and a
18 second for approval of staff recommendation on Item
19 No. 9.
