



REMARKS/DISSENTING COMMENTS:

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Issue 2: Should the Commission approve FPL's UCD tariffs and associated charges?

Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should approve FPL's proposed UCD tariffs and associated charges as shown in Attachment A of staff's memorandum dated July 20, 2023, effective 30 days after the Commission vote. Staff reviewed FPL's supporting documentation for the UCD charges and believes the charges are cost based and reasonable.

Issue 3: Should the Commission approve FPL's proposed revisions to Tariff Sheet Nos. 6.300 and 9.722?

Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should approve FPL's proposed revisions to Tariff Sheet Nos. 6.300 and 9.722 as shown in Attachment A of staff's memorandum dated July 20, 2023 effective 30 days from the Commission vote. Furthermore, staff recommends approval of FPL's request to include the waived existing facilities cost for all non-hardened overhead distribution facilities in net plant in service.

Recommendation: If a protest is filed within 21 days of the issuance of the order, the tariffs should remain in effect, with any revenues held subject to refund, pending resolution of the protest.
