The Governor's office forwarded a copy of your August 10th emails regarding Tampa Electric Company (TECO) to the Florida Public Service Commission (FPSC). The FPSC regulates investor-owned electric, and natural gas utilities throughout the state, and investor-owned water and wastewater utilities in those counties which have opted to transfer jurisdiction to the FPSC. The FPSC has authority in the telephone industry which is limited to the Lifeline Assistance Program, Florida Relay Service, and pay telephone service. We appreciate the opportunity to respond directly to you.

We previously advised you in our July 26th email about the FPSC's March 7th approvals for a mid-course correction to the fuel factors and granted preliminary interim storm restoration charge for TECO.

We appreciate you sharing your additional views and will add your correspondence to both Dockets 20230001 and 20230019 regarding the mid-course correction and the storm restoration recovery, respectively.
