ISSUE 5: What are the conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2024 through December 2024?

DEF:	Customer Class Residential General Service Non-Demand	ECCR Factor 0.330 cents/kWh 0.290 cents/kWh

ISSUE 6: What should be the effective date of the new conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

DEF: The new factors should be effective beginning with the first billing cycle for January 2024, and thereafter through the last billing cycle for December 2024. The first billing cycle may start before January 1, 2024, and the last billing cycle may end after December 31, 2024, so long as each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the factors became effective. (Rodriguez)

ISSUE 7: Should the Commission approve revised tariffs reflecting the energy conservation cost recovery amounts and energy conservation cost recovery factors determined to be appropriate in this proceeding?

DEF: Yes. The Commission should approve DEF's revised tariffs reflecting the energy

conservation cost recovery amounts and energy conservation cost recovery factors determined to be appropriate in this proceeding. The Commission should direct Staff to verify that the revised tariffs are consistent with the Commission decision.
