I am a resident of Wedgefield, in Orange County. We have Pluris for our water service. Our community pays exorbitant amounts for our water supply. In addition a recent lawsuit was brought against Pluris regarding water safety. This lawsuit was won but now we are informed that the company wants to raise our rates for water by almost 50% and sewer over 100%! It seems that they are trying to recoup the cost of the lawsuit from us. We, as a community, looked into purchasing Pluris however what was explained was that we would pay approximately \$45 per month more for 18 years to fund the purchase. Understandably, this was not deemed a good idea by most residents. However now we are facing a rate increase. So either way we have to pay much more for water that is not consistently safe. I ask you to vote against the rate increase. Personally my family will also be supporting a second look at purchasing the water company.
