1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 CHAIRMAN FAY: All right. Commissioners, our
3 last on the move staff agenda this morning will be
4 Item No. 17, and it will be presented by Mr.
5 Hampson.

6 MR. HAMPSON: Good morning, Commissioners.
7 This is Corey Hampson on behalf of Commission
8 staff.

9 Item 17 is Florida Public Utility Company's
10 petition for approval of cost recovery factors for
11 January 2024 through December 2024 for the gas
12 utility access and replacement directive known as
13 GUARD.

14 The GUARD surcharge recovers costs associated
15 with replacing problematic pipelines and
16 facilities, as well as the relocation of mains and
17 service lines located in rear easements to the
18 front lot easement. The Commission originally
19 approved the GUARD program in Order No. PSC
20 2023-0235-PAA-GU.

21 At 20 therms per month, the proposed monthly
22 GUARD surcharge totals to 65 cents for customers on
23 the RES-2 tariff. Staff believes the calculation
24 for FPUC's GUARD revenue requirement and surcharges
25 for each rate class are reasonable and accurate.

1 Staff, therefore, recommends approval of the
2 proposed GUARD surcharges effective for January
3 1st, 2024.

4 Thank you.

5 CHAIRMAN FAY: Great. Thank you, Mr. Hampson.

6 All right. Commissioners, any questions or
7 comments for Mr. Hampson on this item?

8 Showing none, we will take up a motion.

9 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Mr. Chairman, move to
10 approve the proposed charges.

11 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Second.

12 CHAIRMAN FAY: Okay. We have a motion and a


