Dear Mr. Johnson:

Staff has completed its initial review of your application and has determined that St. John's River Estates Utility, LLC. (SJR or Utility) is eligible for a staff-assisted rate case (SARC). The filing fee for this rate case is \$1,200 (\$1,000 for water and \$200 for wastewater) based on the capacity of the Utility's system as provided by Section 367.145(2), Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Rule 25-30.020(2)(t), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The filing fee was paid on January 30, 2024, which is the official filing date for this rate case.

Please forward a copy of SJR's application for a SARC to the Chief Executive Officer of Putnam County as required by Section 367.091(2), F.S., which states:

Upon filing an application for new rates, the utility shall mail a copy of the application to the chief executive officer of the governing body of each county within the service areas included in the rate request. The governing body may petition the Commission for leave to intervene in the rate change proceeding and the Commission shall grant intervener status to any governing body that files a petition.

Please file an affidavit stating that this requirement has been fulfilled. The affidavit should be sent to the address below. Please include the docket number (20230131-WS) on all filings with the Commission Clerk.


