Dear Clerk of the Commission,

I respectfully request you to DENY Environmental Utilities (EU) application for installation of a central sewer on Don Pedro Island. As a resident at 331 Bocilla Dr, Placida, FL (Don Pedro Island) this is the SECOND request to DENY EU's application. It is unfortunate that they even filed another application after they were denied the first time. This is a waste of tax dollars in our community and the Public Service Commission's time.

I have not requested a sewer to be installed on our property, much less the island. There is NO NEED for this service as property has septic system. I do not want the added expenses of installing a sewer system and losing

easements on my property. I do not want the system on the island much less close to my home. The costs alone for installing a private sewer from a private company would make us reconsider our residency on Don Pedro Island.

A privately owned sewer utility would be detrimental to the island for costs, traffic, environmental concerns, and the event that the company forfeits their business and "closes up shop".
