EU is not a contractor and has no experience in installing sewer. They are a private for profit company, again, with no experience in owning wastewater systems.

There is no proven need for sewer. I have lived on the west coast of Florida for 59 years. There are several reports of spilled sewage during storms from just Pinellas County only, which have polluted waterways incredibly.
