**NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION
REGARDING DUKE ENERGY FLORIDA, LLC'S RESPONSE TO STAFF'S FIRST
REQUEST FOR PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS (NOS. 1-9)**

Duke Energy Florida, LLC (“DEF”), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), submit this Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification of information or documents provided in DEF’s Response to the Staff’s First Request for Production of Documents (Nos. 1-9). The confidential documents have been filed with the clerk and the redacted versions have been submitted as part of DEF’s Response to the respective questions. Specifically, DEF’s responses to Request for Production No. 6 contain confidential proprietary business information relating to competitive business information of both DEF and third-party companies. The disclosure of this information to the public could adversely affect the Company’s competitive business interests and efforts to contract for goods or services on favorable terms. Furthermore, the release of this information could adversely impact the proprietary rights of third parties, therefore impacting the company’s competitive interest and ultimately have a detrimental impact on DEF’s customers.
