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1 PROCEEDINGS 2 CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Let's move to Item No. 8. 3 Mr. Smith, you are recognized. 4 MR. SMITH: Good morning, Commissioners. Lee 5 Smith with Commission staff. Item 8 addresses the suspension of tariffs 6 7 related to Duke Energy Florida's petition for a 8 permanent base rate increase. 9 Duke filed its test year letter on 10 January 31st, 2024. Duke then filed its petition, 11 direct testimony and a minimum filing requirements 12 on April 2nd, 2024, for three test years, including 13 calendar years 2025, 2026 and 2027. 14 Duke has requested increases in its retail 15 rates and charges to generate \$593 million in 16 additional gross annual revenue effective 17 January 1, 2025, \$98 million effective January 1, 18 2026, and 129 million effective January 1, 2027. 19 Duke asserts that the combined increases will allow 20 the company to earn a return on equity of 11.15 21 percent. Staff recommends the tariffs associated with 22 23 these increases be suspended pending a final 24 decision in this docket, and to give staff and 25 intervenors sufficient time to analyze the case,
