Please refer to FPL's 2024 Ten-Year Site Plan, Schedule 2.2, Column (16) "Sales to Ultimate Customers" and Schedule 2.3, Column (21) "Total Average Number of Customers." Table 1 below reflects portions of these schedules with staff's calculations of the incremental changes in sales and customer numbers. Please explain the reasons behind the projected decrease in sales with a projected increase in customer numbers for 2024.

RESPONSE:

The forecasted 2024 "Sales to Ultimate Consumers (GWh)" is lower than the 2023 actual amount primarily due to weather. Weather normalized 2023 "Sales to Ultimate Consumers (GWh)" are 123,787 GWh, which is lower than the 2024 projection.

The forecasted 2024 "Sales to Ultimate Consumers (GWh)" is higher than the weather normalized 2023 "Sales to Ultimate Consumers (GWh)" due to the influence customer growth has on sales.
