**SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION**

ANPI Business, LLC (“Applicant”) requests authority pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.71 of the Commission’s Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, to discontinue the switchless long distance and toll-free services that it provides to certain business end user customers (the “Services”) in multiple states. To accommodate timely discontinuance, Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission issue its Public Notice no later than August 31, 2024. In support of this Application, Applicant submits the following information:

**I. Description of Discontinuance**

**1. Name and address of carrier**

ANPI Business, LLC

**2. Date of planned service discontinuance**

Applicant plans to discontinue the provision of the Services on August 31, 2024 in all states except Arizona, which will be discontinued on September 7, 2024 (together, the “Discontinuance Date”), because the servers used to support the Service are at their end of life and no longer supported by their manufacturer and therefore must be decommissioned August 31, 2024.

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Applicant understands that this Application will be automatically granted on the 31st day after public notice of filing unless the Commission notifies Applicant to the contrary.

**3. Geographic areas of service affected**

The affected customers are in evergreen status and Applicant has not marketed or offered the Services, which have been grandfathered, to new customers for at least several years, the discontinuance will only affect those states where there are existing customers.<sup>1</sup> A list of those states is provided in **Exhibit A**.

**4. Brief description of the type of service affected**

Applicant seeks approval to discontinue the provision of switchless long distance and toll-free services provided to business customers that were originally provide by Applicant's predecessor-in-interest, Zone Telecom, Inc. ("Zone Telecom").

**5. Brief description of the dates and methods of notice to all affected customers**

Written notice to all affected customers was sent via email on June 6, 2024. An updated notice that complies with state requirements was sent to affected customers in New Jersey and Ohio via email on June 7, 2024. Any email notices that were returned as undeliverable were successfully re-sent to those customers via an alternate email address or hard copy via FedEx on June 12, 2024. Samples of the customer notice letters are attached as **Exhibit B**.

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<sup>1</sup> Applicant notes that under Section 63.71(g), "a carrier is not required to file an application to discontinue, reduce, or impair a service for which the requesting carrier has had no customers or reasonable requests for service during the 30-day period immediately preceding the discontinuance." Except for the states identified in Exhibit A, Applicant has had no customers or requests for service in any state during the 30-day period immediately preceding the discontinuance. Therefore, Applicant is not required to file an application with respect to any state other than those identified in Exhibit A. Nevertheless, out of an abundance of caution, Applicant seeks approval to discontinue the Service throughout the United States.

**6. Non-dominance of carrier with respect to the services to be discontinued**

Applicant is non-dominant with respect to the long-distance and toll-free services that it proposes to discontinue.

**7. Service**

In accordance with Section 63.71 of the Commission's rules, Applicant has mailed a copy of this Application to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications for the Secretary of Defense and to the Governors and Public Utilities Commissions listed in the attached Certificate of Service which, out of an abundance of caution, also includes jurisdictions where Applicant has no customers receiving Service.

**III. Circumstances of Discontinuance**

Applicant is discontinuing its Services because the servers used to support the Services are at their end of life and no longer supported by their manufacturer and therefore must be decommissioned by August 31, 2024. Further, the Services are provided using a custom-built system that cannot be readily or cost-efficiently moved to other servers or platforms. Further, Applicant has not marketed or otherwise offered the Services to new customer for at least several years. Applicant, therefore, has determined to discontinue the Services.

The discontinuance of the Services is not only necessary and appropriate due to the decommissioning of the outdated servers supporting the Services but will also not adversely affect the public convenience and necessity. The public will not be harmed by the discontinuance because

customers have been given prior notice of the discontinuance along with guidance on timing of seeking out a new service provider. The Services that are being discontinued are also readily available from other carriers, including Applicant's affiliates, and Applicant will work with customers to transition them to other carriers' services if requested to do so. Applicant has provided the minimum 30-day notice required by the Commission for discontinuance of domestic services and requests that the Commission place its Application on public notice as soon as possible.

#### **IV. Conclusion**

Applicant believes that the proposed discontinuance is reasonable and necessary. As outlined herein, Applicant will take reasonable steps, to the extent it is able, to ensure that the discontinuance of the switchless long distance and toll-free services is not unduly disruptive to the present or future public convenience and necessity. Accordingly, Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission permit it to discontinue the switchless long-distance and toll-free services to business customers on August 31, 2024.


