Pursuant to Sections 366.093(3)(c) and 366.093(3)(d), and 366.093(e), Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Duke Energy Florida, LLC ("DEF") requests confidential classification of certain information and documents provided in response to OPC's 10th set of interrogatories (Nos. 245-276) and 10th request for PODs (Nos. 94-105); specifically, responses to interrogatory Nos. 257, 263, 265 and 268 and POD Nos. 94, 97 and 98. This filing was received as a replacement for a faulty disc (see document number 07189-2024, a memo to return the original filing to the utility). The document number for the confidential filing is 06945-2024, and the document number for the request for confidential classification is 04569-2024.

DEF's response to ROG Nos. 257 and 265 and POD Nos. 94, 97 and 98 contains information and data that was used to produce a dismantlement study. The DEF response to ROG No. 263 includes pricing information for real estate transactions. The DEF response to ROG no. 268 contains cost-related data related to an energy storage project. In its request for confidential classification, DEF asserts that disclosure of this information would impair DEF's ability to compete in the marketplace.

Staff has reviewed DEF's confidentiality request and agrees that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Sections 366.093(3)(c), 366.093(3)(d), and 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 06945-2024 be approved.
