Pursuant to Sections 366.093(3)(d), and 366.093(e), Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Duke Energy Florida, LLC ("DEF") requests confidential classification of certain information provided information or documents provided in response to OPC's 7th set of interrogatories (Nos. 144-210) and 7th request for PODs (Nos. 66-77); specifically, responses to interrogatory Nos. 155, 158, 160, 166, and 186, and responses to POD Nos. 66, 68, 71, and 72. The document number for the confidential filing is 07298-2024, and the document number for the amended request for confidential classification is 04342-2024.

DEF's response to staff interrogatory Nos. 155, 158, 160, 166, and 186 contains contract terms for goods and services. DEF's response to staff interrogatory Nos. 206, 207, and 208 contain property tax information. DEF's response to POD Nos. 66 and 68 contains compensation related information ofr employees. POD Nos. 71 and 72 contains pricing and other related information about future transmission planning and related topics. In its request for confidential classification, DEF asserts that disclosure of this information would impair DEF's ability to compete in the marketplace.

Staff has reviewed DEF's confidentiality request and agrees that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Sections 366.093(3)(d) and 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 07298-2024 be approved.
