Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Duke Energy Florida, LLC (Duke or Company) requests confidential classification of the Late Filed Exhibit Request No. 5 dated June 26, 2024.

The Company is claiming confidentiality of its filing under Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S. Per the Statute, propriety of confidential business information includes, but is not limited to: Subsection (d) “[i]nformation concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms.”

More specifically, the information at issue relates to a power equipment supplier of Duke and the warranties that come with these products. The Company claims disclosure of this information would be harmful to its competitive interests, and as such, the information is entitled to confidential treatment.

Staff has reviewed the Company’s information and confidentiality request. It is staff’s opinion

that the information subject to this request meets the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S.
