On June 6, 2024, Duke Energy Florida, LLC (DEF or Company) filed a request for confidential treatment of Document No. 06049-2024. This document contains confidential information from a response to Sierra Club's sixth request for PODs (Nos. 30-32); specifically response to No. 32. The confidential information contained within the response can be described as project work orders to repair or replace equipment on DEF generation facilities.

In its request for confidentiality, DEF asserts that disclosure of this information would harm DEF, as the information relates to proprietary confidential business information concerning repairs or replacements of equipment on DEF generation facilities, and associated contractual data. If disclosed it may impair the Company's ability to contract for goods and services on favorable terms and also impair the competitive business of the provider of the information.

Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with DEF that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would impair DEF's ability to contract goods or services, and could alter contractors' behavior to the detriment of DEF, its customers, and its affiliates. Therefore, staff recommends the request by DEF for confidential classification of Document No. 06049-2024 be approved.
