2 CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Let's move to No. 6.

3 Ms. McClelland, you are recognized when you

5 MS. McCLELLAND: Good morning, Commissioners.
6 This is Kate McClelland with the Division of
7 Economics.

8 Item No. 6 is a petition by St. Joe Natural
9 Gas Company, or St. Joe, for approval to terminate
10 the Hurricane Michael temporary storm recovery
11 surcharge. The surcharge was implemented in a
12 settlement agreement approved by the Commission in
13 Order No. PSC-2020-0117-PCU-GU to recover
14 incremental storm restoration costs associated with
15 Hurricane Michael, and was to extend through
16 December 2024.

17 As of May 2024, St. Joe has fully recovered
18 costs associated with the storm, and is requesting
19 approval to terminate the recovery surcharge and
20 prevent any further overrecovery. Overrecovery
21 will be handled through the natural gas
22 conservation cost recovery charge.

23 Staff has reviewed the petition and the fourth
24 revised sheet number 83, and believes that the
25 Commission should approve St. Joe's tariff

1 modifications.

2 Staff recommends that St. Joe has recovered
3 more than the amount of incremental storm
4 restoration costs permitted in its settlement
5 agreement and should terminate the surcharge
6 effective the day of the Commission vote.

7 CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Thank you for the summary.

8 Commissioners, is there questions or

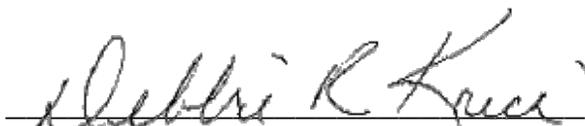
