2 CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Let's move to Item No. 10,
3 the final item on the Move Staff.

4 Ms. McClelland, you are recognized when you
5 are ready.

6 MS. McCLELLAND: Good morning, Commissioners.
7 This is Kate McClelland with the Division of
8 Economics.

9 Item No. 10 is a petition by Peninsula
10 Pipeline Company and Florida Public Utilities
11 Company requesting Commission approval of their
12 transportation service agreement.

13 Florida City Gas currently provides natural
14 gas transportation service to FPUC on the Pioneer
15 Header. Following the transfer of Pioneer Header
16 to Peninsula, this agreement would replace the
17 existing agreement between FPUC and FCG, and would
18 allow Peninsula to provide service to FPUC.

19 The purpose of the agreement is to maintain
20 and reinforce FPUC's natural gas distribution in
21 Palm Beach County, enabling FPUC to serve their
22 current and future customers.

23 If approved, FPUC would pay monthly
24 reservation charge to Peninsula for the
25 transportation of gas, and recover these costs

1 through the PGA and swing service mechanisms.

2 Staff has reviewed the proposed agreement and
3 believes that it is reasonable and meets the
4 requirements of Section 368.105 of the Florida
5 Statutes. Staff recommends that the Commission
6 should approve the proposed agreement.

7 CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Thank you for the summary.
8 Commissioners, is there questions or
9 discussions on Item No. 10? Questions or
10 discussions?

11 Seeing none, is there a motion?

12 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Move to approve, Mr.
13 Chairman.
