### **SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION OF AT&T**

AT&T<sup>1</sup> applies for authority under Section 214(a) of the Communications Act, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.71 of the Federal Communications Commission's ("Commission") rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, to grandfather certain legacy TDM-based voice

services for 253 customers (who subscribe to 309 lines) in sections of 13 states who inadvertently may not have received notice of AT&T's November 16, 2023 Section 63.71 application to grandfather these same services (the "November 2023 Application").<sup>2</sup>

In connection with the November 2023 Application, AT&T mailed notice to customers of AT&T Residential Local Service and AT&T Business Local Exchange Access Line Service (the "Affected Services") located in sections of 13 states where there is virtually no demand for the services. The November 2023 Application was deemed automatically granted on February 6, 2024.<sup>3</sup> As AT&T explained in that application, in the 60 wire centers covered by that application, AT&T had received *no* new orders for AT&T Residential Local Service in the five months preceding the application.<sup>4</sup>

Recently, AT&T learned that a small percentage of the customers of the Affected Services in the area covered by the November 2023 Application inadvertently did not have customer notices associated with that application mailed to them (the "Omitted Customers"). The Omitted Customers comprise 212 customers of AT&T Residential Local Service (who subscribe to 213 lines), and 41 customers of AT&T Business Local Exchange Access Line Service (who subscribe to 96 lines), located in 49 wire centers in sections of 13 states (the "Affected Service Area").<sup>5</sup> A technical error associated with AT&T's ongoing database

migration efforts resulted in the inadvertent exclusion of records for the Omitted Customers from the database AT&T relied on in preparing the November 2023 Application. After learning of these Omitted Customers, AT&T first adjusted its systems to ensure that the Omitted Customers were not actually subject to grandfathering (*i.e.*, they could still make changes to their service, including restarting their service after cancellation.) Then, AT&T carefully reviewed its records to confirm that there were no other Omitted Customers. Lastly, to help ensure such errors do not occur in the future, AT&T updated its processes for identifying and noticing customers impacted by proposed service changes.

On or before July 2, 2024, AT&T notified the Omitted Customers of AT&T Residential Local Service in the Affected Service Area of the proposed grandfathering. On or before July 5, 2024, AT&T notified the Omitted Customers of AT&T Business Local Exchange Access Line Service in the Affected Service Area of the proposed grandfathering. The notices explain that, subject to regulatory approval, no changes to the Affected Services can be placed after September 1, 2024. Copies of the notices to customers of AT&T Residential Local Service and AT&T Business Local Exchange Access Line Service are included as Exhibits 1 and 2 to this application.

As AT&T explained in the November 2023 Application, grandfathering the Affected Services, which are outdated and prohibitively expensive for AT&T to maintain, will benefit the public and serve as an important step toward meeting both AT&T's and the Commission's goals of advancing the IP revolution. Because there are numerous cost-effective, superior alternatives for prospective customers in the Affected Services Area to choose from and because most

centers with Omitted Customers of AT&T Business Local Exchange Access Line Service contain fewer than 10 lines, and no wire center contains more than 18 lines.

customers have already left for such alternatives in droves, grandfathering the Affected Services in this area will not impair the public convenience or necessity.<sup>6</sup>

Effective on or after September 1, 2024, pending regulatory approval, AT&T will not permit the Omitted Customers to make new orders or changes to the Affected Services.

### **Brief Description of Type of Service Affected:**

This application is related to AT&T Residential Local Service and AT&T Business Local Exchange Service used by Omitted Customers in the Affected Service Area.

AT&T Residential Local Service is a TDM-based exchange access line service comprised of the serving central office line equipment and all outside plant facilities needed to connect the serving central office with the network interface at the demarcation point of the customer premises. The service includes optional custom calling features and the End User

Common Line service, which allows the line to facilitate local exchange, intrastate interexchange and interstate voice calling.

AT&T Business Local Exchange Access Line Service provides individual business customers with telecommunications service within a specified geographical area for local calling and access to and from the telecommunications network for Long Distance Message Telecommunications Service.

As explained in the November 2023 Application, the public convenience and necessity will not be impaired by the grandfathering of these services. The demand for these services and the other Affected Services is very low. The very small base of existing customers has been steadily declining, and new customer orders for the Affected Services have virtually disappeared. As a result, it is prohibitively expensive for AT&T to continue to make the Affected Services available for new customers. Active customers of the Affected Services will not be losing service with this filing.

Individuals and businesses in the Affected Service Area have many cost-effective alternative options to choose from as replacements for the Affected Services if they do choose to unsubscribe to the Affected Services. These alternative options include AT&T's next generation solutions — AT&T Phone – Advanced and AT&T Phone for Business – Advanced. In addition, there are many competitive voice offerings offered over cable, fiber, fixed wireless, mobile wireless, and satellite technologies, which most customers have already selected in lieu of the Affected Services.

#### Brief Description of the Dates and Method of Notice to All Affected Customers:

Customer notices were sent via U.S. Mail on July 2, 2024 to the Omitted Customers of AT&T Residential Local Service, and on July 5, 2024 to the Omitted Customers of AT&T

Business Local Exchange Access Line Service.<sup>8</sup> Copies of this Application are being sent via first class U.S. Mail to the governor, public utility commission, federally recognized tribes (if any) in the Affected Service Area, and to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications to the Secretary of Defense, as required by Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's rules.<sup>9</sup>

## Regulatory Classification of Carrier:

AT&T offers the Affected Services pursuant to non-dominant carrier regulation.


