On July 10, 2024, Tampa Electric Company (TECO or Company) filed a request for confidential treatment of Document No. 07453-2024. This document contains confidential information from a response to FL Rising and LULAC's Ninth Request for Production of Documents, No. 58. The confidential information contained within the response can be described as feasibility studies for TECO generation units provided from a third party vendor.

In its request for confidentiality, TECO asserts that disclosure of this information would harm TECO, as the information relates to competitive interests. Furthermore, TECO states that the Company treats the highlighted information provided in Document No. 07453-2024 as private and has not publicly disclosed it.

Staff has reviewed the documents and concurs with TECO that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would impair competitive business interests. Therefore, staff recommends the request by TECO for confidential classification of Document No. 07453-2024 be approved.
