SUMMARY OF THE RULE

Rule 25-6.0183, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), Electric Utility Procedures for Generating Capacity Shortage Emergencies, establishes the Florida Reliability Coordinating Council, Inc.'s (FRCC) Generating Capacity Shortage Plan (FRCC Plan) as the Commission's plan to address generating capacity shortage emergencies within Florida. The rule amendments incorporate by reference the most current Florida Reliability Coordinating Council (FRCC) Generating Capacity Shortage Plan, provide an additional means to obtain a copy of the incorporated material, and otherwise update the rule language for clarity and consistency.

WRITTEN STATEMENT OF THE FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES JUSTIFYING THE RULE

The Florida Reliability Coordinating Council (FRCC) updated its Generating Capacity Shortage Plan in November of 2023, necessitating an amendment to the rule to incorporate by reference the updated version of the FRCC Plan.
