**RE:** Docket No. 20240109-TA-Petition for expedited review of Somos, Inc.'s denial of application for numbering resources for the Daytona Beach rate center, by MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services.

---

On July 16, 2024, Verizon Access Transmission Services (Verizon) filed a request for additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (Somos) for the Daytona Beach rate center. Verizon requested one block to meet their customer's request for 400 consecutive numbers in the 386 NPA. On July 16, 2024, Verizon's request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the utilization criteria.

On Tuesday, July 30, 2024, Verizon filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn Somos' decision. In accordance with Section 2.07C.5.d(2), of the Administrative Procedures Manual (APM), staff has examined Verizon's petition and has determined the following:

- The carrier has demonstrated that it has customers in need of numbering resources;
- The carrier has shown that it will be unable to provide services to these potential customers because of Somos' denial of the numbering resources; and
- Customers will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of Section 2.07C.5.d(2), of the APM have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (August 20, 2024), as outlined in the APM expedited code denial process. Somos should be directed to provide Verizon the numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the Daytona Beach rate center.
