Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Tampa Electric Company ("TECO") requests confidential classification of certain information sent in response to Office of Public Counsel's (OPC's) Tenth request for Production of Documents (PODs). More specifically, the information which confidentiality is sought relates to POD No. 132 regarding Copies of Emera USA's computation of consolidated taxable income for 2020 through 2025.

According to TECO, the disclosure of this information would harm the ability of the company and its affiliates to do business as the document includes information consisting of labor rates, and calculations related to TECO and its affiliates.

Staff has reviewed TECO's confidentiality request and agrees that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 03317-2024 be approved.
