Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Tampa Electric Company (TECO) requests confidential classification of certain information contained in the response to the Office of Public Counsel's (OPC's) First request for Production of Documents (PODs). On April 30, 2024 TECO filed a Request for Confidential Classification and Request for Temporary Protective Order, DN 02604-2024, requesting classification of POD No. 1. On August 8, 2024, TECO submitted DN 08326-2024 which amended DN 02604-2024's Exhibit A, and corrected misidentifications of confidential material.

According to TECO, the documents contain material cost and labor rates for TECO, their affiliates, and their contractors. TECO claims this information is confidential and the disclosure of it would impair the competitive ability of the Company to contract for goods and services.

Staff has reviewed TECO's confidentiality request and agrees that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 08326-2024 be approved.
