TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY’S RESPONSE TO OPC’S AMENDED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE POST-HEARING BRIEF

Pursuant to Rule 28-106.204, Florida Administrative Code, Tampa Electric Company, (“Tampa Electric” or the “company”) responds in opposition to OPC’s Amended Motion For Extension of Time to File Post-Hearing Brief (“Motion”) filed on October 14, 2024 [DN 09503-2024], and states:

1. The Motion seeks an extension of the deadline to file post-hearing briefs in this docket and as it bases cites: (1) availability of the transcript of the final hearing and (2) Hurricanes Helene and Milton.

2. Despite the transcript delay, the significant damage to Tampa Electric’s system from Hurricanes Helene and Milton, and the impact storm restoration efforts have had on the company, Tampa Electric will be ready to file its post-hearing brief on the current deadline of Wednesday, October 16, 2024.

3. Tampa Electric requests that the Motion be denied.
