Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statues (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC or Company) requests confidential classification of certain information filed in the above-referenced docket, dated October 14, 2024.

The Company is claiming confidentiality of its filing under Section 366.093(3)(a), F.S., and Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S. Per the Statute, propriety of confidential business information includes, but is not limited to: Subsection (a) "[t]rade secrets," and Subsection (d) "[i]nformation concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms."
