Complaint: Improper Billing against Tampa Electric Company

Details:

I am requesting that this board block Teco's request to raise electricity prices significantly this year, as due to the damage inflicted from hurricane Helen and Milton, it's hard to recover AND have your bills double over the course of a month that you barely used electricity in. On top of this, our usage has stayed the same, and although it's understandable that with a larger population in Tampa comes more need for price increase, at some point it becomes unlivable to have the prices increase on basic necessities when they're already as high as they are. In my home, we make an effort to keep the A/C stable, wash and dry our clothes on certain days, and maintain lights off if not in use, yet for some reason, the prices of these bills keep coming in unreasonably high to the point where we need assistance to pay them, even if were technically supposed to be in the self sufficient middle class.
