SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION

Global Crossing Local Services, Inc. (FRN: 0003-7331-44) and Global Crossing Telemangement VA, LLC (FRN: 0026-0946-49),<sup>1</sup> (collectively referred to herein as “Global Crossing”) hereby applies for authority to discontinue service to its remaining customers of various Voice over Internet Protocol (“VoIP”) services that have operated on a VoIP platform part of which has reached the end of its service life and is no longer technically supported. Pursuant to Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) authority, these and other services were grandfathered earlier this year.<sup>2</sup> Global Crossing now requests Commission

authority to discontinue VoIP services in all fifty states, the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico.

Global Crossing submits the following information in support of its application:

**1. Name and address of carrier**

**2. Date of planned service discontinuance**

Global Crossing plans to discontinue the Affected Services on December 31, 2024, or as soon thereafter as any necessary regulatory approvals are obtained.

**3. Points of geographic areas of service affected**

Global Crossing seeks authority to discontinue VoIP service in all 50 states, the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico.

**4. Brief description of the type of services affected**

Global Crossing seeks to discontinue the following VoIP services:

- Voice-based service which provides PSTN access for TDM and IP telephony customer premises equipment bundled with network access
- Long Distance Service provided over a VoIP platform which allows domestic calls outside of a defined local calling area
- International Long Distance (ILD) Service provided over Time Division Multiplexing (TDM) or IP Based facilities which allows calls originating in one country to terminate in a country other than the United States
- Toll Free Service provided over a VoIP platform which allows domestic calls to originate from anywhere in the United States or Canada and terminate to the customer's location at no charge to the calling part
- International Toll-Free Service (ITFS) and Universal International Free Phone Number (UIFN) Service provided over IP Based facilities which allows calls to originate from international countries. ITFS provides the ability to have

different a toll-free number per country, whereas UIFN provides the same toll-free number for multiple countries

**5. Brief description of the dates and methods of notice to all affected customers**

Global Crossing sent a written notification of the planned discontinuance to customers affected by the proposed grandfathering in accordance with Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's Rules. Customer notifications were sent by U.S. Mail or United Parcel Service on October 18, 2024. A copy of the notification is attached to this application (Attachment A).

**6. Dominance of carrier with respect to the service to be discontinued**


Global Crossing Local Services, Inc. and Global Crossing Telemangement VA, LLC are considered non-dominant with respect to the services to be discontinued.


