Issue 1: Should the Commission approve the proposed 2025 Territorial Agreement between Talquin and Quincy, dated September 5, 2025?

Recommendation: Yes, the Commission should approve the proposed 2025 Territorial Agreement between Talquin and Quincy in Gadsden County, as consistent with the standards for approval set forth in Rule 25-6.0440(2), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The proposed 2025 Territorial Agreement, if approved, adjusts the territorial boundary line set forth in the utilities' 1995 Territorial Agreement, allowing the joint petitioners to accommodate future loads in a more efficient and cost-effective manner. Also, the terms of the proposed 2025 Territorial Agreement would permit the joint petitioners to avoid unnecessary duplication of transmission and distribution facilities as well as better serve the future needs of their respective customers.
