1	PROCEEDINGS
2	CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Let's move to Item No. 2.
3	Ms. Brownless.
4	MS. BROWNLESS: Thank you.
5	This item was deferred from the November 4th
6	Agenda. As you recall, the City of Quincy and
7	Talquin Electric Cooperative originally petitioned
8	to resolve the territorial dispute to determine
9	which utility would serve a proposed development on
10	Bostic Road.
11	The Bostic development has four phases, Phases
12	1 through 3 being located in the disputed area, and
13	Phase 4 being located in Quincy's area in the 1995
14	Territorial Agreement, which expired in 2010.
15	In order to resolve this dispute, the parties
16	executed the 2025 Territorial Agreement, which gave
17	Phases 1 to 3 1 through 3 of the Bostic property
18	to Talquin, and Phase 4 to Quincy. This
19	territorial agreement was the subject of the
20	November 4th Agenda.
21	At that Agenda, Mr. Wesley Cox, speaking on
22	behalf of himself and his brother, stated that they
23	had been decades-old customers of Talquin and did
24	not wish to transfer to Quincy, citing quality of
25	service and billing complaints. The Cox property

1	is separate and apart from the Bostic property.
2	The parties filed an amended 2025 Territorial
3	Agreement on November 4th, which is substantially
4	identical to the terms of the original 2025
5	Territorial Agreement with one exception. The Cox
6	properties are now included in Talquin's service
7	territory.
8	The amended 2025 Territorial Agreement is
9	before you today. It is in compliance with the
10	provisions of Rule 25-6.0440(2), Florida Statutes,
11	and is not expected to result in uneconomic
12	duplication of services, or cause a decrease in the
13	reliability of any present or future customers.
14	For these reasons, staff recommends that the
15	amended 2025 Territorial Agreement be approved.
16	Kevin Forsthoefel and Malcolm Means, on behalf
17	of Talquin, are here today to answer any questions
18	you may have, as is Gary Roberts, on behalf of the
19	City of Quincy.
20	Thank you.
21	CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Great. Thank you for the
22	summary.
23	Commissioners, any questions or discussions on
24	this item.
25	Commissioner Graham.

1	COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Thank you, Mr. Chairman.
2	It's just interesting that they say you can't
3	fight City Hall. The guy came down here and was
4	heard, and I am glad they came to an agreement.

9	amended territorial agreement, Mr. Chairman.
10	COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Second.

15	CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Yay.
16	Opposed no?
