We are retired customers of Water Oak Utility in Lake County and we arewriting to oppose the proposed water rate increase under Docket No Gotta Have It.: 2025088-WU.

The proposed increase-from roughly \$15.00 per month to more than \$100.00 per month-is excessive and would create a serious financial hardship for us and the other retired residents living on fixed incomes. We understand that water is an essential service, and we customers have no alternative provider. This substantial, excessive increase is neither responsible nor affordable.

We respectfully urge the Commission to reject or significantly reduce this proposed rate increase and to prioritize affordability and consumer protection for residents of Water Oak, a 55 and over retirement community.
