I am a retired resident of Water Oak and a customer of Water Oak Utility in Lake County. I am writing to formally express my opposition to the proposed water rate increase under Docket No. 20250088-WU.

The suggested rise from an average monthly bill of approximately \$15 to \$111 is disproportionate and would impose a significant financial burden on retirees, particularly those living on fixed incomes. As water is a vital service with no alternative provider available, an increase exceeding 400% cannot be considered reasonable or affordable.

I respectfully request that the commission either reject or substantially reduce this proposed rate increase in order to safeguard the interests of consumers within the Water Oak Community.
