As a resident and all residents are requesting immediate attention for Florida PSC to reconsider the proposed rate increase and exploring alternative solutions. All Water Oak residents are impacted by our annual rent and pass on fees which the rate absorbs are COLA increase. We are all experiencing a lack of maintenance due to Sun Community/Water Oak lack of attention to many request regarding main water line breakage, street repairs, fencing (40 years old) that was signed off to be replaced in the 2025 budget. We continue to do our part by remaining a resident and accepting increases each year with no reward for repairs being done in a timely manner. This is a 55 and older community and a lot of residents have lost their spouse/companion along with their income and trying to survive on our own which is forcing some of us in our 70's back into the employment world. Please consider the impact on the senior citizens of this community before awarding addition increases to Sun Communities/Water Oak Community.
