I, too, would like to formally protest. The proposed increase to our water costs at Water Oak Country Club, Lady Lake. We are a 55+ community, and the fact that Sun Communities is asking for a 300 to 400% increase in our water utility bills, shows me that Sun has little regard for the people in this park.

My Objection: I object to this rate increase as it will put undo harm financially on my husband and me. We are beginning Social Security and Medicare, and find that it is unfair that we should have to take additional jobs to pay needed expenses monthly.

My justification: I am not aware that Sun Communities has had any expenses for repairs or modifications that would justify such an increase. This seems like a blatant way to increase our lot rent without being restricted by the covenants in our Prospectus.

I hope the PSC will do their due diligence in investigating this proposed increase. My feeling is this is nothing more than corporate greed by taking advantage of elderly citizens.
