I am writing in Opposition to the proposed Residential and General Service Rate Increase per 1,000 gallons. of monthly water use.

The current rate is \$1.17; the proposed rate is \$9.77. This is an Increase of 735% per the letter we received in the mail only 7 days ago! This is a staggering and exorbitant increase for an essential service such as water. This sharp escalation can feel catastrophic for seniors on a fixed income.

Please hold Sun Communities/Water Oak accountable to the October 2025 Audit findings identifying accounting irregularities, incomplete records, and revenue reporting issues. As a result, invoices that do not directly and currently provide safe and useful water to residents should be fully disallowed.
