Dear Mr. Dose

I live in Beverly Hills, Florida, the area affected by docket 20250136-WS

This proposal is problematic for several reasons:

**1. Onerous High Percentage Rate of Increase**

The proposed fix-rate increase (stated as \$19.61 per month) is hundreds of percent over what it is now. This is especially burdensome to retired and low income customers.

**2. No ability to Mitigate Costs by Reducing Usage**

If I am reading the proposal correctly, the \$19.61 additional cost is charged irrespective of usage (similar to a meter fee). This means families who are burdened by this are unable to mitigate the cost by reducing their own water usage.

### 3. Lack of Accounting Statement Information

There is no information to justify the request. There is just an amount given, without explanation of how this figure was obtained. Additionally, there are no contractor estimates. There is just a dubious expectation that we are all supposed to trust CSWR and fork over more money to whatever it says.

For these foregoing reasons I respectfully request the Commission reject CSWR's request of 20250136-WS.
