Comment: I feel the proposed water rate increase is excessive-anywhere from 78%-156%-190%. Service has been interrupted many times due to water main breaks. 10 in 2023, 29 in 2024 and 15 in 2026. I would also question the 2.4 people in an average household. Most here are 2 person households and many are just one.

The 2026 Social Security COLA was a mere 2.8%. Many rely on Social Security as their main source of income. With a rent increase of 5% this year and projected 7% next year many are struggling now without this excessive increase.

I respectfully request that the Commission reject this rate increase.
