We are writing to express our concerns regarding the proposed water rate increase at Sunlake Estates in Lake County. We feel an increase of 78% to 190% is drastic, and would place a

financial burden on the residents here. We are an over 55 community and most of us are on a fixed income. No where on our monthly water bill does it say SLEU, so we were not aware that's where it comes from or who to contact if we have concerns. In the seven years we have lived here, we have never seen the SLEU attempt to reach out to the community on reducing or managing our water usage.

This proposed water rate increase seems drastic and unreasonable to us, and we are asking that you give serious consideration to this matter.
