As a resident of Sunlake Estates for almost eight years I would like to voice our shock and displeasure regarding the insane proposed increase in our water bill. The drastic increase (78% to 190%) is totally unwarranted and will be a financial burden on the majority of the residents living here. The vast majority are retirees living on fixed incomes and a substantial number of widows and/or widowers squeaking by on their social security and/or some kind of pension.

Can someone explain how you justify such a large increase? Whenever we have a water main break we are inconvenienced and over the last 3 years we have had to deal with over 55 breaks. This in and of itself is bad enough but I don't recall anyone offering us a break on our water bills. Apparently Sun Community has failed to pass this info onto to SLEU. Water is not a luxury we can just say we don't need, it is a necessity of life. And per our prospectus we are mandated to water our lawns twice a week and pressure wash once a year.

Several of our neighbors have submitted very eloquent letters regarding this situation. I have read them and agree wholeheartedly with their concerns and comments.
