We are writing to express our strong opposition to the proposed water rate increase of 78% to 190%. This increase drastically places a financial burden on most households in this community. All the plines and water quality does not justify for this drastic increase. Many residents in the 55+ Community are on a fixed income and this increase will force them to choose between water service and other essentials, food, Rx, and housing upkeep. There is already a 5% rent increase this year and a projected 7% rent increase next year. Many are already struggling to pay their increased pass-through taxes.
