

Dear Sir:

My name is Virginia Robinson, and I am strongly disagreeing with Sun Lake's request for a water rate increase.

I have been a resident for twenty three years, am currently a widow, and in no way use 25,000 gallons of water in a month. That was the amount printed on my May '26 bill.

I have never seen anyone check the meter for accuracy, nor have any of my neighbors.

No one has ever received notice that their water use has gone up dramatically.

I asked a resident who repairs irrigation systems to check, and he discovered 1 sprinkler head that was broken underground, the hot that directs the zones for sprinkling had a valve that was leaking and allowed a constant amount of water to escape. I also replaced the main control box that determines length of time, day, and duration of sprinkling.

In spite of all repairs and at significant cost to me, my May bill was 144.78

I sincerely hope that in the future my bills will not reflect a rate based on the past 3 months.

Does the Commission monitor water usage?

Is it possible to have periodic checks on our usage?


If the object is to conserve water, does it make sense to notify residents of suddenly increasing usage, so that potential problems may be corrected?
