21	we are in the process of finishing up the tail of
22	the tape for '18-'19. We're closing the books and
23	will be contacting your offices in the next few
24	days to square up some time and give you the brief
25	on that at your convenience.

3	CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay. Thank you, sir. Any

5	All right. Other matters. Does anybody have
6	other matters?
7	I have one. I have received a letter from one
8	of our Florida Representatives, Wyman Duggan of
9	District 15. It's concerning a utility, Normandy
10	Village Utility, Co-op, Inc. He's got some
11	concerns and some specific questions. I've given a
12	copy of this, both to staff, general counsel and
13	executive director, and asked them to look into it
14	to see if we can't get some answers. I'd like to
15	encourage staff, number one, to get back to me
16	within about 30 days or so, just so I can reply to
17	this letter. And then however long it takes you
18	guys to get into some more of the facts. I'm fine
19	with that, as well. I didn't know if any
20	Commissioners had any probative questions. Staff.
21	MR. BAEZ: Appreciate your forwarding it to
22	us, Chairman, and we are actively looking at it and
23	we'll be in contact with your office and any of the
24	other offices that may have an interest to try and
25	brief you on what the status is and what we may

1	have found out. In terms of a response to the
2	legislator, we can depending on your pleasure,
3	we can turn something around rather quickly.
4	Obviously that will leave open open-ended
5	questions based on our investigation. So it's
6	however you want to handle it, we can
7	CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Let's give them a letter
8	back quickly just saying, we received your comments
9	and your questions and we're doing a deeper dive
10	into it.
11	MR. BAEZ: We'll work with your office.
12	CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay.
13	MR. BAEZ: Thank you.
14	CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: All right. Any other
15	matters?
