The parties should file at least two annual reports addressing the effectiveness of the proposal in avoiding uneconomic duplication and ensuring reliable service.

Issue 2: Should this docket be closed?

Recommendation: Yes. If no person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed agency action files a protest within 21 days of the issuance of the order, this docket should be closed upon the issuance of a consummating order.

DECISION: The recommendations were approved.
