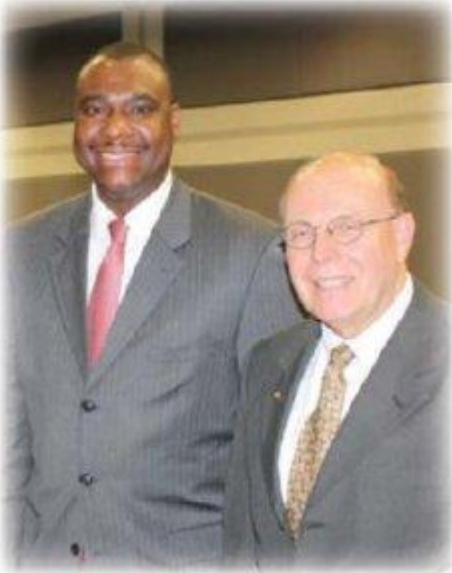




The Florida Public Service Commission's
