In October, Commissioner Gabriella Passidomo was appointed to the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners' (NARUC) new Natural Gas Resource Planning Task Force. NARUC President Michael Caron announced establishment of the task force during the NARUC Summer Policy Summit in July.



Comprised of Commissioners from across the country, the task force was established to connect utility regulators with tools, expertise, and platforms to share information and develop refined visions for commission-led planning processes that will help them navigate the challenging energy landscape in the coming decades.

Task force members will engage with other states and experts to help accelerate their understanding of the costs, benefits and trajectories of various pathways to meet state policy goals and strategies to facilitate meaningful stakeholder engagement, all while minimizing cost burdens on customers.
