

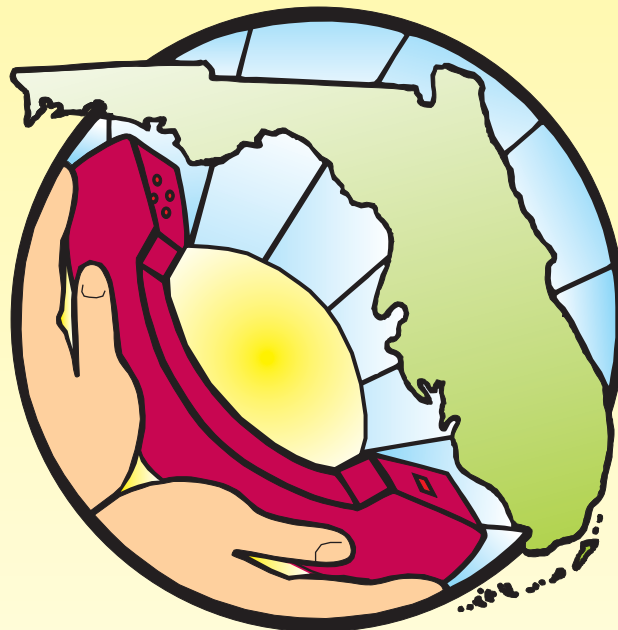
The **Lifeline Assistance Program** provides up to a **\$13.00** credit on qualified residential customers' local monthly phone bills, including a federal credit of **\$9.50**, and a matching credit from their telephone company of **\$3.50**.

Link-Up Florida provides up to a **50%** reduction in the telephone service hook-up charge, to a maximum of **\$30.00**, making telephone service affordable to low-income consumers in our state.

You may be eligible for savings if you prove that you are receiving benefits under one of these programs:

- ✓ Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF)
- ✓ Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- ✓ Medicaid
- ✓ Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)
- ✓ Federal Public Housing Assistance (Section 8)
- ✓ Food Stamps
- ✓ Bureau of Indian Affairs' Tribal TANF
